When the 1 day roster applies your watering day is in green. When the 2 day roster applies you can also water on your extra day, in blue

*** Last digit of your house/lot**

To find your watering days, take the last digit of your house number and apply it to the water roster above, eg. 12 Rose Street - last digit of your house number is 2. Unit 3, 355 Rose St - last digit of your house number is 5. If your property does not have an assigned house number please use the last digit of your lot number.

You may only water once, before 9am or after 6pm.
You can water with a hand held hose at any time.

This roster applies to scheme water users. Bore users should contact the Department of Water for any current restrictions on (08) 6364 7600.

Sprinkler Bans

Should a sprinkler ban be in force residents may only use a handheld hose or watering can. For the latest water restriction information visit www.busseltonwater.wa.gov.au or call Customer Service on 9781 0500.

What are water efficiency measures?

Water efficiency is about using less water and making the most of every drop of water that we use.

State-wide water efficiency measures include a permanent watering day roster scheme and a winter sprinkler ban. Water efficiency measures affect all water users including scheme water users, garden bore owners, business and Government.



I HAVE JUST PLANTED A NEW LAWN CAN I GET AN EXEMPTION?

If you are establishing a new lawn or garden you may apply for an exemption in order for it to become fully established. The customer must confirm that the new lawn or garden has been planted to be granted an exemption. New lawn can refer to roll on, shredded and/or seed lawn.

DOES THE 2 DAY PER WEEK WATER ROSTER APPLY TO BORE OWNERS?

The water roster does not apply to garden bores in the Busselton area; however, all bore water users must comply with the daytime sprinkler ban i.e. no watering between 9am and 6pm.

OTHER WAYS TO SAVE WATER IN THE GARDEN

In addition to restricting sprinkler use, there are a range of ways you can conserve water in the garden:

- Design your garden with plants native to the area.
- Mulch the garden. Mulch not only discourages the growth of weeds and evens out soil temperature, it can also keep up to 70% more moisture in the soil.
- Install a drip irrigation system. It is more efficient to water the roots of plants rather than the leaves. Drip systems water directly to the root system, don't cause overspray and prevent excess evaporation.
- Reduce your lawn area. Lawn needs more water than the rest of the garden so investigate other options such as using ground covering plants.
- Invest in a pool cover. Not only does it save water; it will also save on chemicals as it helps to maintain a correct chemical balance.

WHAT IS MY WATERING ROSTER DAY?

To find out your watering days, simply take the last digit of your house number and apply it to the Watering Roster.

If your property does not have an assigned house number please use the last digit of your lot number.

You can water only once on your allocated day, either before 9am or after 6pm.

WINTER SPRINKLER BAN

From 2010, a winter sprinkler ban is in force from 1 June – 31 August. Customers may only use a hand held hose or watering can to water lawns and gardens.

Remember to switch off your reticulation system.

BORE USERS- please note that the winter sprinkler ban **does** apply to bore users.
